A Resolution of the NARSTO Executive Steering Committee

Whereas NARSTO (initially named the North American Research Strategy for Tropospheric Ozone) was established by Charter in November 1994;

Whereas NARSTO participating organizations have been unable to assure continued, stable, and equitably distributed funding for NARSTO core activities;

Whereas the NARSTO Executive Steering Committee has directed the NARSTO Management Coordinator to expend his best efforts to:

1. Coordinate all activities needed to ensure publication of the NARSTO assessment, *Technical Challenges of Multipollutant Air Quality Management*, by Springer Science + Business Media.
2. Provide for distribution of the published assessment to authors, editors, and relevant members of the NARSTO community.
3. Maintain continuing access to the NARSTO website and all NARSTO reports and assessments through the Department of Energy's Carbon Dioxide Information Analysis Center (CIDIAC) at Oak Ridge National Laboratory.
4. Ensure that access to the NARSTO field research data archive is maintained through CIDIAC or its successor activities.
5. Preserve all significant information relevant to NARSTO activities and provide for archiving this material at the Department of Energy's Oak Ridge National Laboratory;

Whereas on July 8, 2010 the NARSTO Executive Steering Committee via unanimous vote decided to terminate NARSTO in accordance with the provisions of Article 3 of the NARSTO Charter;

The current Co-chairs of the NARSTO Executive Steering Committee proclaim the termination of NARSTO effective December 31, 2010.
